Professor of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry at the University of Western Brittany in Brest (France). He is the Chief of the department of Child and Adolescent psychiatry at the University Hospital of Brest, Psychoanalyst of the Paris Society of Psychoanalysis, and member of the IPA.
